CATHOLIC STEWARDSHIP APPEAL

As we all prayerfully consider how we can support the diocesan stewardship appeal, I would like to share with you how we have recently benefited from these donations.

During the floods of 2008 I became involved with the United Way NEMO Unmet Needs Committee assisting the local area. Many residents suffered flood losses not covered by Flood Insurance or FEMA or SBA. They were left to find their own resources to repair damaged homes and farmlands. Fortunately many of these people received direct financial assistance at the local level through this NEMO Unmet Needs Committee.

Now you have to ask yourself, *Where did the funds come from?* You may be surprised to learn that our parish was able to request and receive from the Diocesan Social Concerns Committee a grant of \$4,000.00. This generous donation helped to assist 114 residents of Marion, Ralls, Monroe and Lewis counties. **DeAnne Wickens**
