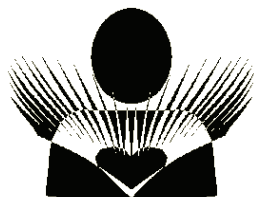

**THREE-IN-ONE COLLECTION**

*Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,*

Soon our diocese will take up the Three-In-One Collection. This Collection gives hope to **Jesus in disguise**. It gives hope to the community that has lost its livelihood to crop failure, hope to the refugee child, separated from her mother, and hope to the immigrant, trying to keep faith alive in a foreign land. The Three-In-One Collection helps to fund programs that give hope to refugees, the impoverished, and immigrants, including victims of war, drought, natural disaster - CRS has been in Haiti for over 50 years and will be there for many years to come working to provide vital aid to the poorest, and help in the long-term rebuilding of what the earthquake and poverty have destroyed. Three-In-One funded programs aid victims of armed conflict; provide agricultural assistance, water programs, health care; resettle refugees and immigrants to the United States; help alleviate poverty in developing countries; provide legal support services for poor immigrants; and advocate for policies and programs that promote global justice and peace.

The Collection also supports the Franciscan care of the Holy Land, and Peter's Pence which will be used to help the Holy Father respond with immediate emergency assistance to the most disadvantaged throughout the world - those who suffer as a result of war, oppression and natural disasters.

**In our Diocese, the Three-In-One Collection is scheduled for March 13-14.** I have set a goal for our Diocese of one hour's wage per family. Please know that your generosity gives hope to **Jesus in disguise**.

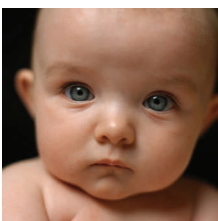
