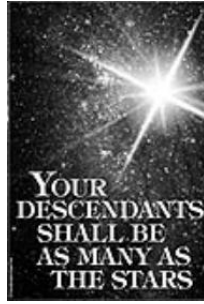

**CHRISTMAS HAPPENS...** A pediatrician I know recently took a job in Burundi. Her first letters back to me were full of frustration and temptations to doubt in God's goodness.

I thought of Christmas. I wrote to her to look again at the reality that faced her. In the midst of all who were not helped and the indifference of those who could and should do more, could she perceive any point of a beauty and strength at work in an unexplainable way? Was there a sign that, in the midst of our misery, God had come?

She wrote of having visited a Catholic center for women with AIDS where she met women who had suffered every sort of rejection and injustice, yet their meeting with Christ in that place had made them joyful and able to embrace other sick women with the same joy. *"I returned home with the desire that this experience of being called by name might happen to me and to my colleagues, who perhaps have never known this love."* She returned with hope.

There is Someone at work. Why does he come so small and so weak? He does not want to take control, but to have us be changed by the discovery of his loving presence, and thus be able to love the unjust and unloved person before us, spreading his kingdom. *(Reflection based on Luke 2:1-14)*

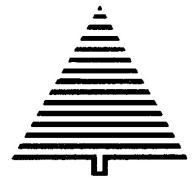

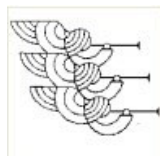
