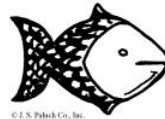
### **LISTEN AND FOLLOW**

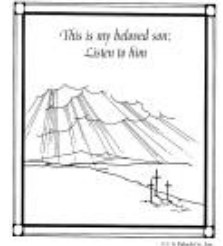
