Divine Mercy Sunday

The Sunday after Easter is always the Feast of the Divine Mercy. This year, it is April 12. In honor of Divine Mercy Sunday we will pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet after all the Masses. This is the only Sunday of the Year that complete forgiveness and pardon including temporal punishment is given if you do the following: 1) Venerate the image of Jesus, the Divine Mercy
2) Go to Mass on the feast of the Divine Mercy and receive Holy Communion
3) Go to confession, within 2 weeks of the feast
4) And last, but not least, extend mercy to others. Please join us for this special Rosary and Veneration.
