PARISH MEETINGS REPORT

We had many people attend our "State of the Parish" meetings on April 11 and 12, and I thank all of you who took the time to listen and offer suggestions. The items of discussion were the financial situation, declining attendance at mass, and suggestions to re-energize our parish.

Our parish is currently operating under a deficit budget, which means if we spend all the money anticipated, and receive only the funds budgeted, we will need to borrow money to pay our bills. Fortunately, we usually don't spend everything anticipated, and hopefully, we will receive more than we anticipated. If you notice the amount we are behind in the Collection Summary each week in the bulletin, you can see that we have a large deficit if we don't start receiving more in collections. Several years of this situation has forced us to use our cash reserves. A contributing factor to this problem is a drop in attendance. The October count (the number of people in church is physically counted each October) has dropped 31% between 2001 and 2014. Nationwide, over 70% of Catholics do not attend church.

All salaries are frozen for the coming fiscal year (July 1, 2015-June 30, 2016) which includes all school and office personnel. We have been struggling to maintain teacher salaries at 87% parity of the public schools, but this year it will drop below 85%. The Finance Committee will revisit the financial situation in January to see if it is possible to give raises at that time. Some suggestions that came from the meetings are:

Treasure: Offer electronic payments; form a Stewardship Committee; publish the parish budget; increase school fees; and make school families more accountable for their giving.

Time & Talent: Offer more groups (singles, young families, etc.); welcoming group for new parishioners; church nursery; update website; have simple activities to keep people connected; follow up with RCIA candidates; youth/contemporary Mass; personal ambassadors; visitor pew cards for more information.

Education: Classes on defending our faith, Eucharist, the Mass; explain scriptures during mass; consult with successful churches (i.e. Bowling Green); educate parish on importance of our school.

Evangelization: Reaching fallen away Catholics; Holy Family yard signs; Renew/discipleship program; more welcoming & inviting people to church.

Spiritual: Parish mission; pray to Holy Spirit for guidance; focus on Eucharistic Adoration 24/7; publish when groups/bible study groups meet.

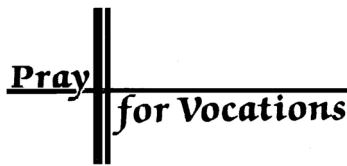
