**Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,**

Many dioceses, including our own, face challenges due to priest shortages, lack of funds, remote geography, or poor parishes. The Catholic Home Missions Appeal answers these needs with grants for projects to strengthen the faith of the people. The Catholic Home Mission Appeal affects the lives of over 9 million U.S. Catholics.

The Marshall Islands cover an area of 500,000 square miles. Travel is often difficult and communication is unreliable. The Islands do not have any native priests and have only one local permanent deacon and sister; and so, the Missionaries of the Sacred Heart provide for the pastoral and sacramental needs of the people. The Marshall Islands welcomed with great joy a seminarian in 2014! Thanks to a grant from the Catholic Home Missions Appeal, they are able to send him to seminary for his studies. He is already a witness and example to other young men on the Islands.

Not all the islands have a resident priest and the Church relies on prayer leaders to lead the Sunday liturgy of Scripture reading and reflection as well as distribution of Communion. Thanks to a grant from Catholic Home Missions, these catechists attend a yearly training and retreat, and new leaders are guided by experienced prayer leaders.

In our own Diocese, a Catholic Home Missions grant helps provide ministry to our growing Hispanic population. The critical work that we do with families, with faith formation, and with lay leadership development is made possible by the Catholic Home Missions.

With your support, next weekend's Catholic Home Missions Appeal will continue to provide catechesis, lay leadership training, seminarian education, and other essential pastoral care. Please be generous and help strengthen the Church at home. Thank you, and God bless you.
