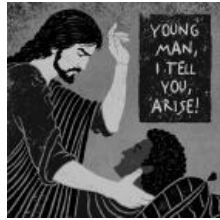

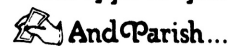

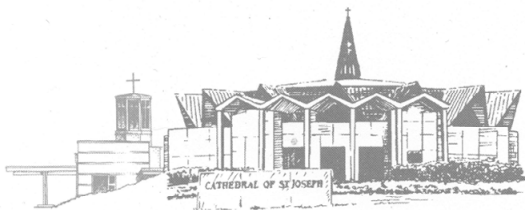

### A Note from Your Diocesan Vocation Director, Fr. Greg Oligschlaeger

Hello and thank you for welcoming me to Holy Family Parish this weekend so that I may speak with you about vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life. It is good to be back in Hannibal. I have lived here ten years of my life while I was a student at St. Thomas Aquinas Seminary from 1981-1985 and then on Faculty at the Seminary from 1996-2002. I always appreciated the relationship St. Thomas Seminary had with Holy Family Parish. Thank you for your hospitality.

For the past eight years, I was pastor at St. Joseph Parish in Martinsburg and Church of the Resurrection in Wellsville. I was appointed vocation director for the dioceses this past July (almost a year ago now.) Now I live at the Cathedral rectory in Jefferson City and my office is at the diocesan Alphonse J. Schwartz Memorial Catholic Center.

I write this letter so that you might know a little bit more about what a Vocation Director is and to tell you a bit about who I am. A Vocation Director is a lot like a tour guide who can help you discover your vocational call from the Lord. When you tour a new place, you are not creating something new and unique. You are getting to know about and understand more fully the place that you are discovering anew. One has a new appreciation for the history, the people, and how the place or object was constructed. A vocation to priesthood or consecrated life is not something you create. A vocation is something God created and has gifted to you. People, who never tour and stay only where they are comfortable, do not get to see all that God may have in store for them.

I grew up in Jefferson City and attended grade school at St. Joseph Cathedral School. In 1981, I went to St. Thomas Aquinas High School Seminary and graduated in 1985. I attended college at the Pontifical College Josephinum, graduating with a Psychology degree in 1989 and completed four years of graduate work in Theology at Kenrick-Glennon Seminary in St. Louis. Since my Ordination to Priesthood in 1993, I have been an associate pastor, a teacher, a dean of students, an administrator, a pastor at 6 parishes, a counselor, a spiritual director, a soccer and golf coach and a chef. I work an afternoon a week in the Tribunal Office in our diocese, and I get to attend a few St. Louis Cardinals baseball games a season. Priesthood is an ever-changing, wonderful life for multi-talented men. Please continue to pray for vocations to priesthood and consecrated life.

As the Diocesan Vocation Director, I am honored to speak with you so I can listen to your story, answer any questions you might have, help your parish develop your vocation committee, and help or guide as you discern God's plan for yourself and this parish as we go on a tour of your spiritual journey.
