Dear Parish Family,

Thank you for continuing to give to our parish building fund.

This summer we sold our rectory for \$88,500 and \$50,000 of that has been applied to the debt on our new rectory on West Ridge. We now owe about \$35,000 on the new rectory.

Our building fund is used for major repairs on our parish properties. Right now our convent needs to be painted and our gym needs new heaters.

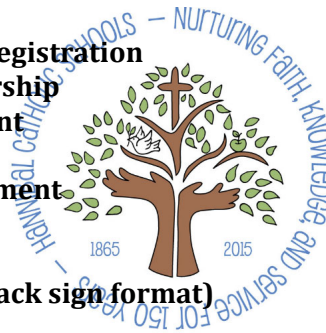
