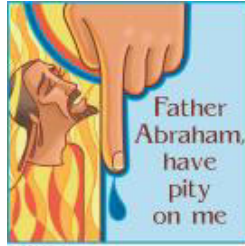
+Anointing of the Sick- can be done privately at home, at Church or in the hospital

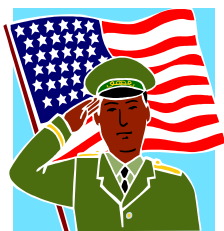
