Dear Parish Family,

Thank you for continuing to give to our parish building fund.

This past summer we sold our rectory for \$88,500 and \$50,000 of that has been applied to the debt on our new rectory on West Ridge. We now owe about \$34,000 on the new rectory. Our convent has been painted this fall and our youth room has been renovated. New heaters have also been put into the gymnasium of our school. Our building fund is used for major repairs on our parish properties. We will keep you informed of any repair and improvement needs as they arise. 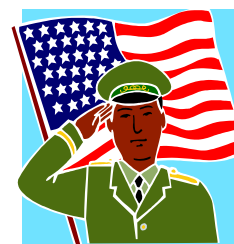
