Dear Parish Family, Thank you for continuing to give to our parish building fund. This past summer we sold our rectory for \$88,500 and in July of 2016, \$50,000 of that was applied to the debt on the rectory. We saved \$26,464.35 in interest by making the payment in July.

On November 1, 2016 we paid an additional \$25,000 on the rectory debt. The balance owed on the rectory as of November 4, 2016 is \$21,749.01. Once again, thank you for your generosity! God continues to richly bless our parish as we faithfully and lovingly serve Him.

ADVENT... "Early on in our church, ADVENT was celebrated for forty days, like the season of Lent. Although it is now only four weeks, the symbolism remains. Because of the similarities, ADVENT is sometimes nicknamed the "Little Lent". Purple is the liturgical color, with the first Sunday symbolizing HOPE and the second Sunday FAITH.

Our Scripture readings at Mass tell of the old prophecies pointing to the coming of the Lord. We are called to watch and to leave our sinful ways behind. There is a light coming that will shine through the darkness, bringing us to the third Sunday, Gaudete Sunday, and the liturgical color, rose, signifying JOY."

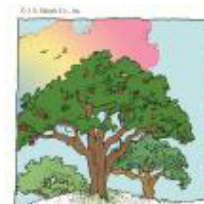
