PARISH COUNCIL MINUTES

Last Tuesday evening, the Parish Council met. Attending were Fr. Mike, Fr. Dolan, Sr. Mary, Sr. Betty, Marisa Ellison, Rich Fogle and Libby Manning. The meeting was opened with prayer. Fr. Mike reminded everyone of the retreat on March 11 with Joe Nassal. Social time begins at 8:30 a.m., presentation begins at 9 a.m., and will conclude by attending mass at 5:30 p.m. All are encouraged to sign up online at myhollyfamily.com.

On February 22, Carolyn Saucier will present "Call to Discipleship" starting at 6:30 p.m.

Fr. Dolan shared efforts for the Hispanic ministry. He is encouraging our parishioners to be welcoming and offers Spanish mass regularly. Eventually, our parish will be blended.

Sr. Mary reported the "Souper Bowl of Caring" will benefit the Good Neighbor Project and encourages participation.

Sr. Betty shared Catholic Schools Week is the last week of January and our students will be participating in the masses. They will be voting on the official "t-shirt design" for the week. She distributed the Holy Family Alumni Newsletter, this one being the second distributed and focused on charitable giving. It was suggested an "Alumni" link be put on the school link on the myhollyfamily.com web site. The Home and School Association will feature the students demonstrating the new Chrome Books they received as a result of the Holy Family Auction proceeds.

Parish Council was asked to consider donating an item, as a group, to the auction. After discussion, it was decided the Council members are already donating in other ways and decided to decline the invitation. Marisa will respond to the auction committee.

Fr. Mike reported that Renee Fisher is being trained to post on our Facebook page and web site, and both she and Patty will be trained in Flocknotes, the system that will provide emails and text messages to parishioners for events. Marisa will work with Doug Riley, Deanne Wickens, Renee, Patty and Fr. Mike to establish a process for postings.

Eric Hagan resigned from the Parish Council. Members were saddened to accept his resignation and held good discussion about ensuring our Council is representative of our parish. Fr. Mike will review our demographics/commissions, and Libby will talk with the Stewardship Committee to provide us information at our next meeting to evaluate those who have already expressed interest in getting more involved.

Finally, members reviewed the draft vision statement and held discussion. The draft vision statement is: ***We invite and welcome all to a spirit-filled and loving church where we come together and celebrate Jesus.*** Council members present discussed the statement and were encouraged to consider the draft, seek out ideas, and bring those back to the meeting in February, at which time the vision statement will be determined.
