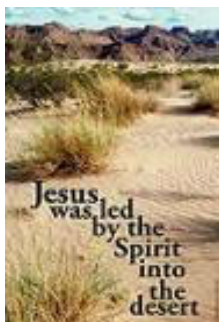

**RCIA Rite of Sending and Rite of Election**

Today at the 8:00 A.M. Mass we will celebrate the **Rite of Sending** with our **catechumens** who are awaiting Baptism : **Zach Beamer, Brian Chaplin, Whitney Fisher and Chris Brownell**. We celebrate also with our **candidates** who are already baptized in another faith tradition. The Church has discerned their readiness for reception into the Catholic Church this Easter. After the rites are celebrated this morning, these catechumens and candidates, along with their godparents and sponsors will be sent by our parish to the bishop for the **Rite of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion**. Bishop John Gaydos will declare the catechumens to be the elect, chosen by God for the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist this Easter. The bishop also recognizes the desire of the baptized candidates for the sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist within the Catholic community. Please continue to pray for all those in the RCIA process as they continue on their journey of faith into the Catholic Church.
