PARISH COUNCIL - MAY MINUTES

Present: Fr. Mike, Sr. Betty, Sr. Mary, Libby Manning, Collin Anderson, Marisa Ellison

At the May meeting, Father Mike and Sister Mary took all responses from the meeting with Deacon Ken Berry on "Christ's call...Our response - Pastoral Plan" that was held on April 11th and compared/combined it with the February 20, 2016 visioning meeting led by Sr. Kathleen Wegman. The object of this was to determine our Pastoral Plan priorities for the next 3 to 5 years within the parish. It was noted that not everything will be accomplished during the first year. The following are the initiative, priorities and outcome desired for the next 3 to 5 years:

Initiative: Youth**Priorities:**

- 1) Emphasis on middle school youth program, specifically new middle school youth coordinator/s
- 2) Stronger High School Confirmation program
- 3) More involvement in liturgy
- 4) Support teens transitioning from high school to college

Outcome desired: Youth fully engaged in the parish

Initiative: Adults**Priorities:**

- 1) Continue small faith sharing groups
- 2) More in-depth catechesis on faith knowledge of church
- 3) Revival of CRHP or equivalent

Stewardship committee will assist with this area

Outcome desired: Adults alive with educational opportunities and faith experiences

Initiative: Young Families**Priorities**

- 1) Support Groups
- 2) Mentors

Establish new committee to work on this

Outcome desired: Young families more engaged in the parish

Priority: Utilize Social Media for outreach

- 1) School curriculum
- 2) Youth group connecting

Establish new committee to work on this and identify current social media administrators

Outcome desired: Better communication within the parish

As you can see there is a great deal of work to do in order to make progress on these priorities. The plan of action is due to the Diocese in July, so it is very important that our parish council participate in the direction. Please pray thoughtfully about the priorities and bring ideas to the June 6 meeting.
