Next Wednesday, September 27, in his weekly audience, Pope Francis will officially launch a global campaign in support of migrants and refugees. The U.S. Catholic Church will be joining this campaign, called *Share the Journey*. Sponsored by Caritas Internationalis, the campaign is being led in the United States by several USCCB Committees, Catholic Charities and Catholic Relief Services. Following the launch, the USCCB is calling for a **Week of Prayer and Action Oct. 7th through Oct. 14th.**
