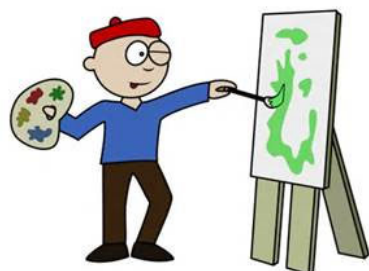
**School Secretary Position**
