Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Just a couple of weeks ago I had the honor of ordaining three men to the priesthood. One of them, Father Cesar Anicama, has obvious ties to our missions.

He is from a parish in Pisco, Peru with which we began a mission partnership after the 2007 earthquake. His pastor, Father Jose Sanchez, helped him discern for the priesthood, just as one of our missionaries, the late Monsignor Ralph Keyes, helped Father Sanchez many years before. He told me that he urged Cesar to come here because of the deep missionary spirit of our people.

What happened in our missions some 40 years ago is still affecting lives today. We have to believe that what we continue to do in our mission commitment not only serves people now but will also be a channel of God's love for many years to come.

When we help parishes nourish the lives of families, we assure another generation of caring disciples to serve their communities. When we offer food to hungry children or medicines to the destitute, the lives we touch may well pay it back one hundred fold to others. When we preach a Gospel of justice and hope, we empower people to work together to change the world in which they live.

Mission is not about getting more priests or any other benefits. It is about a living expression of our faith and about sharing the love of Jesus with those who need it most. The fact is, though, that the more we do this, the greater the blessings we find.

Our other ordinands were Father Simeon Etonu from Nigeria and Father Geoffrey Brooke, Jr., whose mother is from Ecuador. We have been truly blessed by these and others with links to the mission world. Next weekend is our Diocesan Mission Collection. It is our turn to give back. Please be generous.
