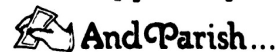

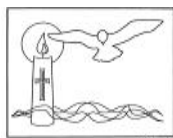

Friends, family, and all here at Holy Family:

I have decided to leave seminary. I believe very strongly that it was God's Will for me to go to seminary, but that it is also His Will for me to be a saintly person in the lay state of life: to get married and be a daddy. After 5+ years of discerning, with much growth, and 2 and a half years in the seminary, I could not be more grateful to God the Father for loving me as much as He does. He has truly pursued me all my life long, and I am eternally grateful, forever a changed man. I have never been or felt as close to Him, His Church, or His people as I am now.

I went to seminary in part, I think, because I was attracted to certain things that priests do: they're set up to live a holy life; they are intimately tied with the Eucharist; they preach and teach the Faith; etc. One of the many, many things I was able to learn through this process was that being attracted to these things and being called to priesthood are not *necessarily* the same thing. That was the case for me.

I still love Jesus Christ and His Church very much, but please continue to pray for me as I move forward! As for what's next--I have just started an internship in the Diocese of Des Moines in the Office of Evangelization and Catechesis...very exciting! It's temporary: a bridge. I don't know what it's a bridge to, but it's a perfect bridge to whatever God has next in store for me.

Thank you for all your love and support. I have received so much of God's love through so many of you Holy Family parishioners. I am—and will always be—eternally grateful. Please pray for me and may God bless you always in the love of Christ Jesus the Lord! - ***Ryan Welch***
