PARISH COUNCIL ABBREVIATED MINUTES

Parish Council met on March 14, 2017. In attendance: Fr. Mike, Sr. Mary, Sr. Betty, Libby Manning, John Hark, Marisa Ellison, and Lindsay Anderson.

Sr. Mary opened the meeting leading the council in the Stewardship Prayer.

Lindsay Anderson was welcomed by all as our newest member of Parish Council. She and her husband, Collin, will serve as one member. They are representing the young families in our parish.

Fr. Mike reviewed the purpose of the Parish Council, which is a leadership body within the parish who develops and implements a mission-focused pastoral plan for the parish.

Sr. Mary provided an update on various activities. Around 125 people attended the Parish Retreat on the Eucharist.

Seven of the eleven small faith sharing groups are using Matthew Kelley's book "Resisting Happiness" during Lent.

The Rite of Sending and Rite of Election was March 5, and Holy Family sent our RCIA elect to St. Joseph Cathedral in Jefferson City.

The RCIA Scrutinies will take place the 3rd, 4th, and 5th weekends in Lent.

During Lent, the Elect began *Breaking open the Word* at one of the weekend masses. They are being dismissed after the homily.

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is being held March 15 for religious ed. students, March 23 for RCIA group, and March 21 is the Parish penance service. She also reminded everyone that Live Stations are March 17 (adults) and March 31 (youth).

Sr. Betty shared the middle school will put on the Passion Play on April 13 at 8:15 a.m. There will be no 8:15 am Mass, only the 7:30 pm Mass of Our Lord's Supper.

The school will have their accreditation visit March 22-24.

She shared results of a school climate survey evaluating the use of a before and after school care program. The results are favorable, and she will be seeking advice and suggestions from the accreditation board who comes in next week.

Grandparents Day at Holy Family School is April 4 - all are welcome.

Official totals from the School Auction are not yet available. The Auction Committee will put a full report in the bulletin when totals are available. The auction supports technology, purchase of textbooks, professional development for our teachers/staff, teacher supplies and more.

Fr. Mike indicated Inviting Catholics Home would be starting March 15.

TEC will be April 8, 9, and 10.

Libby shared the Stewardship Report, which included their fine work of putting on the Parish Retreat. They are also focused on increasing Flocknote usage, there are currently 170 people using the texting and email program. Sr. Mary said there will continue to be more training offered.

The Council finalized the Parish vision statement: *We are disciples of Christ who welcome and invite all to a spirit-filled and loving church where we join together and celebrate Eucharist.* The Council will now focus on evaluating our mission statement.

Fr. Mike led prayer to conclude the meeting.

The next meeting is April 11 at 5:15 p.m. at the Parish Office.
