GOOD NEIGHBOR CHRISTMAS COOKIE SALE



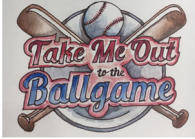

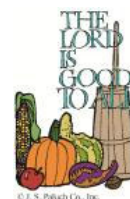
