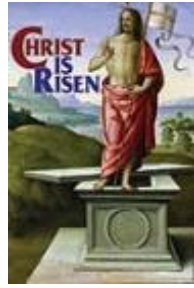

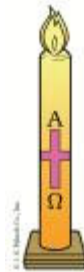

**DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY** Enclosed in this week's bulletin you will find a copy of the Divine Mercy Chaplet. This will be prayed in church next weekend, April 7-8 after the Rosary at all the Masses.

Jesus told St. Faustina that this Feast of Mercy would be a very special day when "**all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened**". (Diary 699) Our Lord made a great promise to all those souls who would go to Confession and then receive Him in Holy Communion on the Feast of Mercy, on the Sunday after Easter, which is now called Divine Mercy Sunday throughout the Catholic Church.

We want to encourage everyone to take advantage of this incredible promise and the additional Plenary Indulgence on this great Feast of Mercy "Divine Mercy Sunday".

Pope John Paul II said that the image portrays the Risen Jesus Christ bringing Mercy to the whole world. Our Lord said "**I want the image to be solemnly blessed on the first Sunday after Easter, and I want it to be venerated publicly so that every soul may know about it. I promise that the soul that will venerate this image will not perish**". (Diary 341, 48)

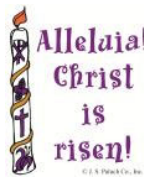
