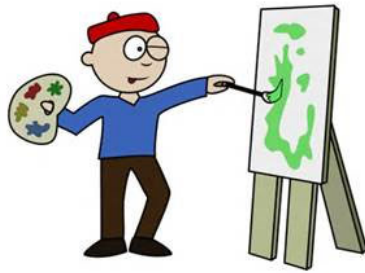
School Secretary Position
